About this issue:

In April, Houston County started offering rewards of up to \$100 for reporting relatively minor crimes like vandalism or theft and \$500 for information about a crime, or plans for a crime, involving a gun. Roughly 2000 schools and colleges across the nation have adopted similar Student Crime Stoppers Programs that offer anonymous ways for students report classmates who carry guns, drugs or alcohol, commit acts of vandalism or break other school rules.
